Matters Arising from Previous Minutes:

1. Craig Road , 3 areas closed off by cones and barriers for some weeks now for no reason as work has been completed at this road .
2. Castle Road sign is still damaged/askew
- 3 Primary School Crossing , Markings still not repainted , nearby drain on Queen Street is blocked .
4. At Queen Street Recycling point , yellow skip has been reported for excessive noise and does it meet accessibility requirements for height
- 5 The Community Garden foot bridge requires repair , reported . Fife Council are looking into repair/ replacement
6. Sea Wall erosion (close to Caravan Park entrance) – getting worse as erosion is undercutting the grassy area.
- 7 Tayport Cemetery – needs attention – Lead officer from Fife Council is coming to discuss.

Foodbanks Report - Consistent usage . Weekly/fortnightly deliveries to 7 – 13 families , total of 395 food parcels handed out since January. Finance is good with Donations from St Andrews University , schools and local church . £200 from choir .
